Hours of work:

Casual – based on programming requirements. Must be able to work weekends and variable hours between 12:00pm and 7:00pm.

Key responsibilities:

- Enjoy working with children and the public
- Ability to react quickly to changing environments, troubleshoot, and offer solutions.
- Strong organizational and multi-tasking skills.
- Available to work weekends, varied hours and some evenings outdoors.
- Ability to sustain physical activity walking up and down stairs, pushing carts, and light lifting.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, mature and professional, with a strong customer-focused attitude.
- Previous experience working with children or in the arts is an asset
